## How to Cite a Print Encyclopedia

1. Author's last name, author's first name. (if provided at the end of your article)
2. "Title of article."
3. *Title of encyclopedia in italics,*
4. Vol. #,
5. Publisher of the encyclopedia,
6. Copyright year,
7. Page numbers of article.

Encyclopedia Britannica, 2002, pp. 1834-35.
