Next week we are wrapping up all Kindergarten instruction. Here are some suggestions for summer enrichment for your child to do at home.

- Read together everyday
 - Read to your child
 - Listen to your child read
 - Sound out words every where you go
- Practice cursive
 - Write a word, sentence, or sentences about a summer vacation
 - Keep a journal with drawing and words about summer experiences
- Use math every day
 - Count things anywhere
 - Make up “some, some more” or “some, some went away” story problems
 - Look for patterns
 - Compare the weather from day to day
 - Measure things
 - Count pennies, nickels, and dimes
 - Identify shapes in nature
- Science
 - Collect rainwater and measure the amount
 - Find the seeds in fruit or vegetables and plant them
 - Go on nature walks
- History
 - Learn the historical relevance to places your family may visit this summer
 - Look for American symbols
 - Think about what it would be like to be a Native American “living off the land”
